
## Using Survey Monkey

### 1. Create an Account





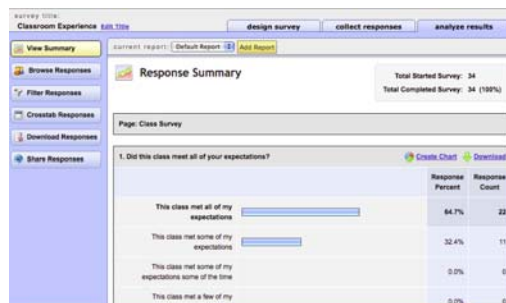
