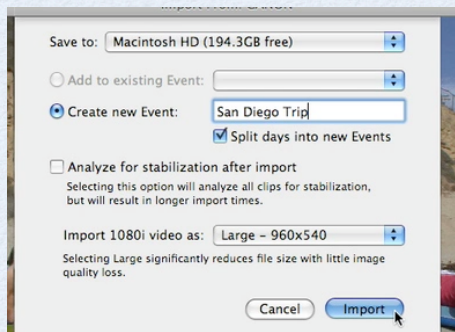


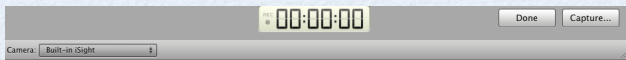
USING IMOVIE

ACQUIRING MOVIES

- File Import: Import movies from a USB device or disc add to a new or existing Event

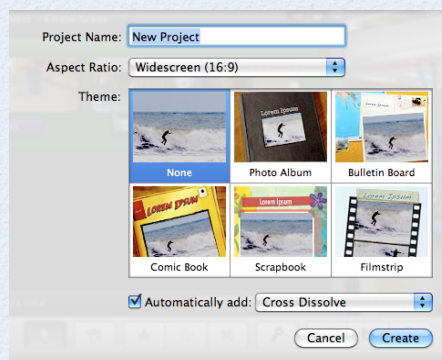


- File: Import from Camera: Record video from your computer or Import movies from an external camera add to a new or existing event



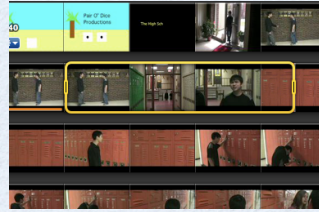
BEGINNING A PROJECT

- File: New Project - Create a new project
- Choose a screen size
- Choose a theme if you wish
- Click Create



BUILD YOUR PROJECT

- Select frames from a clip in one of your events
- Drag the selected frames into the project or click the add to project button
- Continue adding clips

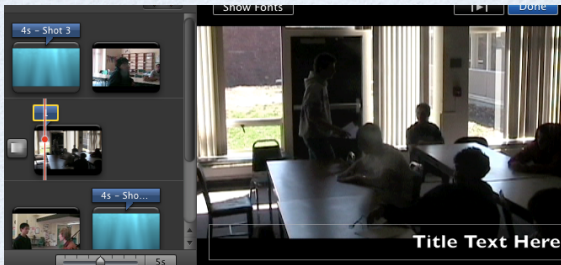


REARRANGE CLIPS

- Move a clip to a new spot in your project
- Add a new clip before or after one already in your project

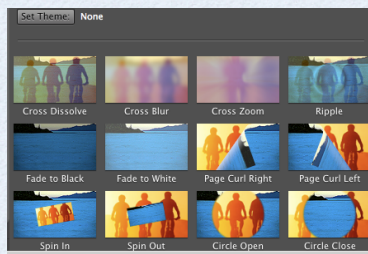
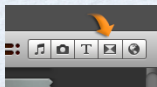
ADDING TITLES

- Click the Titles Button
- Choose a style
- Place it over a clip or before a clip
- Type your title
- Edit the font, color
- Edit size, etc.



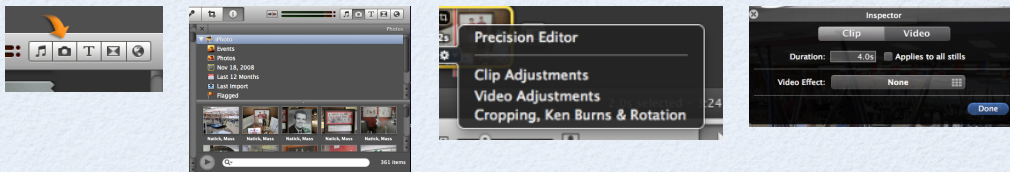
ADD A TRANSITION

- Click the transitions button
- Select a transition and drag between two clips



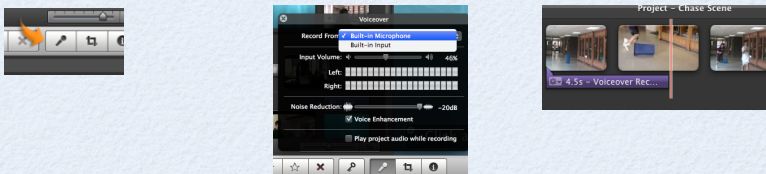
YOUR IPHOTO LIBRARY

- Open the Media Browser
- Drag the photo you want to the project
- Open the inspector to change the amount of time the photo will appear



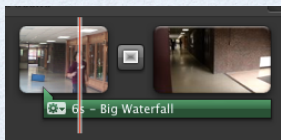
RECORD A VOICEOVER

- Click the voiceover button
- Click the video frame where you want to begin
- Record your voiceover
- Click somewhere to stop recording



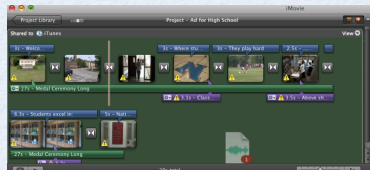
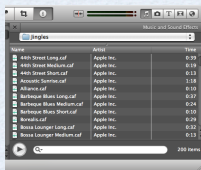
ATTACHING A SOUND CLIP

- Click on the Music & Sound effects button
- Select the sound file you want
- Drag the file over the video where you want it to begin



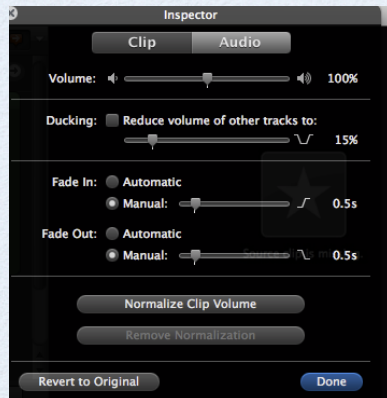
BACKGROUND MUSIC

- Choose Music & Sound Effects button
- Find the music you want
- Drag the file into the gray area
- Use the clip trimmer to adjust the audio



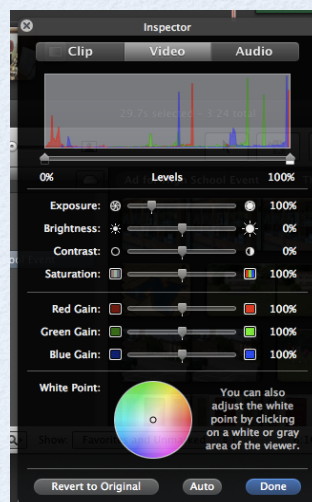
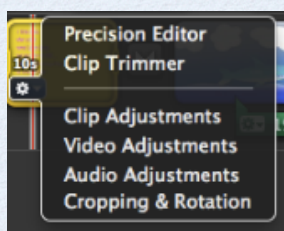
ADJUSTING AUDIO

- Click audio and adjust the volume, add ducking, mute a clip, fade the clip in or out
- Use the clip trimmer to adjust the length of the clip



ADJUST IMAGE QUALITIES

- Double click the video or photo
- Open the inspector
- Click video
- Make adjustments

- Export to Quicktime (The best format)
