

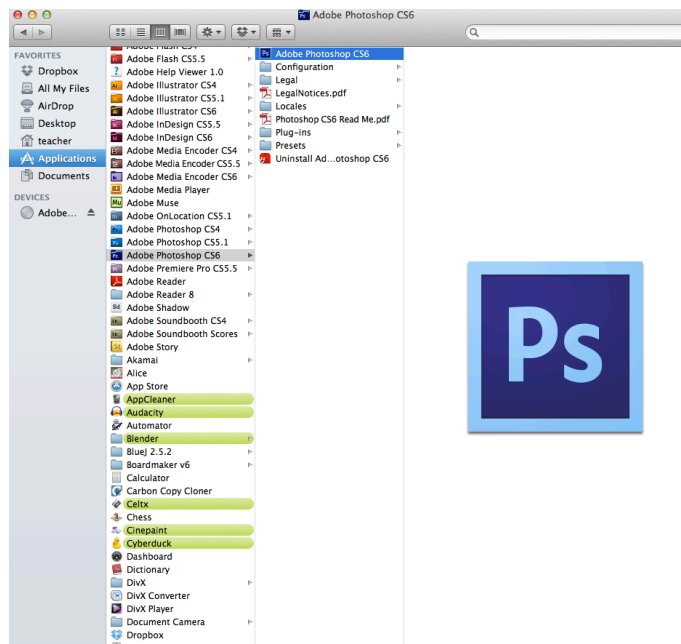
What To Do While Out
