3. **Wire Frame, Side Page-** take a screen shot of your finished wireframe of one side page. Insert the screen shot into a Google Doc. Share the Google Doc with [lcullen@natickps.org](mailto:lcullen@natickps.org) and title the file Web Blue, Wire Frame, side page (this is due at the end of class on Friday.)
4. **Reflection-** write the reflection in a Google Doc. Share the Google Doc with [lcullen@natickps.org](mailto:lcullen@natickps.org) and title the file Web Blue, Reflection (this is due at the start of class on Tuesday, December 4th)
