- 1. Using Dreamweaver create the "Give Back Tuesday" page. We already set up the page and attached it to the appropriate stylesheets. You need to start building and formatting. Create your page based on a charity you would donate to on Give Back Tuesday. Your page can follow any layout but I recommend using the same layout we have used for the past few weeks. Your page has to include the following elements:
  - Nav Bar- with the titles Home, Cyber Monday & Give Back Tuesday. You can have these links just go to Google or # for now.
  - Image- Any image which is appropriate for your site
  - Content- You can place in filler text and then if you have time include your own content
  - Footer- Include your name and Natick High School contact info

When building in Dreamweaver you can use the code approach, Dreamweaver buttons approach or both!

To Submit by the end of Class: By the end of class you need to share a Google Doc with the title "Name of Class, Give Back Tuesday" and in that document include 2 screens shots of your completed file: 1. from the back end of Dreamweaver and 2. Of your page previewed on the Web. For more detailed directions on what to submit please watch the "What to Do While I am Out" video.

Please help each other out and do not be shy to ask a classmate for help! If part of your code is not working problem solve or move onto building another section of your page. YOU CAN DO IT!!
